The Career Readiness “Drive to 65” Act

Beginning with the Freshman class entering in 2020, create a “career-pathway” for students:

- assess student career interests
- advise all entering high school students how to achieve a career ready credential upon graduation
- document future learning pathways to career readiness credentials
- record on a student's transcript progress towards the credential

What is a FUTURE LEARNING PATHWAY?

A FUTURE LEARNING PATHWAY is a college/career pathway system:

- Focuses on BOTH academic and its relationship to career coursework or experiences
- Integrating secondary & post secondary learning opportunities
- **Supported by strong models of advising and counseling**
- **Provides equity of student access to these opportunities**
- Culminates in credentialing acquired through career training and/or education

Grade 9: Exploration of Self & Positive Identity

Embedded curriculum units that focus on:

- **English**: Coordinate book read relating to positive self image & positive choices
- **Social Studies**: Geography courses tie back to community connections
- **Math**: Use performance assessment “What is Right For Me” to investigate college & career choices with support of guidance partners
- **Science**: Connections to career cluster partners & HUOT opportunities

Opportunities to emphasize Portrait of the Graduate attributes & their applicability to student identity + success

Essential question: *What makes me unique?*

Grade 10: Social Competencies and Empowerment

Embedded curriculum units that focus on:

- **Citizenship & English 10**

- Emphasis on student goal-setting & portfolio activities
- Revisit CIVICS performance assessment: “What Is Right for Me?”
- Develop embedded curriculum materials in core courses to support social competence and empowerment
- Learning opportunities leading to future learning pathways opportunities with support from guidance partners

Opportunities to support work that embeds Portrait of the Graduate attributes & their connections to a larger world

Essential question: *What are my goals and path?*

Grade 11: Creating and Engaging in Opportunities

Embedded curriculum units that focus on:

- **US History & English 11**
 - Why life planning is important: student accountability & ownership
 - Action planning & resume building culminating in a junior year review
 - Post secondary opportunities/requirements: duo-enrollment/Running Start experiences, internships, & ELOs
- Creating Future Learning Pathways portfolios that align to & use Portrait of the Graduate as its framework

Inward opportunities to support college/career exploration models embedded in coursework & developed within the community

Essential question: *What is my post-secondary action plan?*

Grade 12: Expanding Possibilities

Embedded curriculum units that focus on:

- **English 12/Senior Seminar**
 - Senior graduation/action planning with the support of guidance partners
 - Project-based & work-based learning experiences
- Expand post-secondary experiences
- Utilize the FLP Portfolio & POG attributes to establish/record certificates of mastery to support the graduation requirement

External opportunities to develop students' vision through real, applied learning embedded in experiences

Essential question: *How am I ready to take on the world?*
